

The St. Vincent de Paul, St. Mary's of St. Clair /Ecumenical Food Pantry

Since 1982 our chapter has helped keep people from being evicted or having their heat, water or electric turned off.

We help with prescriptions, eyeglasses, dental work and any medical deductibles.

We help with any emergency situation that may come up that would help someone in need get just the boost they need to be on their own or help them over a hard time. This includes some help with schooling so they can be self-sufficient.

The pantry workers come from every church in town. At Thanksgiving we gave out 105 food baskets. We delivered over 10,000 pounds of food at Christmas and over 1,400 gifts. We give food vouchers and distributed over 76,000 pounds of food to over 3,600 people from the Ecumenical food pantry in the last year.

All of this is done without any regard to race or religion and is kept in our local community. A special emphasis is taken to help the youth and elderly.
